Application Requirements:

1. Treatment for a feature film or feature documentary, of no more than 8 pages.
(A completed script should be available upon request)
2. 1 Page Cover letter exploring why you want to attend this programme, what you can bring and what you expect to get out of it.
3. 1 Page Directors statement – vision for Project (if attached)
4. **1Page – Cover sheet – Project Artwork (optional)**
5. **1 Page EAVE fact sheet (please see Training page FAW web site)**
6. **1 Page synopsis**
7. **1 Page selling points, marketing strategy and audience**
8. **1 Page Finance plan**
9. **1 Page (half page each) CV Writer & CV Director**
10. **1 Page (half page each) CV Producer & Company Description (if applicable)**

Highlighted items on the application list = information for the “Catalogue of Participants and Projects” which will be sent out to EAVE decision makers.

The selection panel will sit during the week beginning Monday 10th August 2009.
Successful applicants will be offered a place on the programme by the close of business on Friday 14th August 2009

¹ Welsh = born in Wales or current resident.

Stage One

The application requirements of the successful Producers will be sent to the EAVE Group Leader – Ms Roshanak Behesht Nedjad (Roshi) and circulated around the group.

The EAVE Group Leader will use this information as the start point for the bespoke preparatory work for each project, with a focus on Producing / Packaging / Presenting / Pitching

Stage Four

EAVE Workshop Week 3

St David Hotel Cardiff Monday 16th – Sunday 22nd November 2009

3 days lead by EAVE Group Leader Roshi =

- 2 days of Bespoke Workshops + Plenarys (mirroring of EAVE Participants week)
- 1 day – one to one Pitching tutorials

Rest of the week pitching sessions

NB: There will be an introduction session at the beginning of the first day, “A Taste of EAVE” participants will briefly introduce themselves to the 51 EAVE Participants to facilitate integrating them into the Group

Pitching Session

“A Taste of EAVE” projects will be included in the “Catalogue of Participants and Projects”

EAVE will endeavor to facilitate meetings between the “Taste of EAVE” participants and the EAVE decision makers.

Cost for Participants

NB: EAVE Workshop Week 3 participants rate at St David Hotel €1,300, which includes Breakfast, day delegate pack including Lunch, tea & coffee breaks and evening meals.

Or Hotel, Travel, Accommodation, Subsistence & Delegate Rate

A Taste of EAVE Participants do not have to stay at St David Hotel, however they would have to pay a day delegate rate of £50 per day, which would include tea/coffee breaks and lunch but not evening meals.
